### A Psalm of David.

- A1 DAVID'S PLEA FOR VINDICATION: David asks for examination leading to vindication, for he believes he is walking faithfully with God 26:1-3
  - **B1** Request for Vindication: {1} Vindicate me, O LORD, 26:1a
  - **B2** Reasons for Vindication 26:1b
    - C1 for I have walked in my integrity,
    - C2 And I have trusted in the LORD without wavering.
  - **B3** Request for Examination 26:2
    - C1 {2} Examine me, O LORD, and try me;
    - C2 Test my mind and my heart.
  - **B4** Reasons for Examination 26:3
    - C1 {3} For Your lovingkindness is before my eyes,
    - C2 And I have walked in Your truth.

#### A2 DAVID'S DEFENSE OF HIS INTEGRITY 26:4-8

- B1 His Separation from Deceitful Evildoers 26:4-5
  - C1 {4} I do not sit with deceitful men, Nor will I go with pretenders.
  - C2 {5} I hate the assembly of evildoers, And I will not sit with the wicked.
- **B2** His Genuine Participation in Worship 26:6-8
  - C1 His Integrity in Worship <sup>1</sup> 26:6
    - D1 {6} I shall wash my hands in innocence,
    - D2 And I will go about Your altar, O LORD,

- C2 His Proclamation of Praise 26:7
  - D1 {7} That I may proclaim with the voice of thanksgiving
  - D2 And declare all Your wonders.
- C3 His Love for Yahweh's Dwelling 26:8
  - D1 {8} O LORD, I love the habitation of Your house
  - D2 And the place where Your glory dwells.

## A3 DAVID'S PRAYER FOR MERCY BASED ON HIS INTEGRITY 26:9-12

- B1 His Plea to be Spared from the Judgment to Befall Sinners 26:9-10
  - C1 His Request Not to be Classified with Sinners 26:9a
    - D1 {9} Do not take my soul away along with sinners,
    - D2 Nor my life with
  - C2 His Characterization of Sinners 26:9b-10
    - D1 Murderous: men of bloodshed,
    - D2 Wickedness: {10} In whose hands is a wicked scheme,
    - D3 Unscrupulous: And whose right hand is full of bribes.
- B2 His Request for Gracious Redemption in View of His Promised Walk of Integrity 26:11
  - C1 His Promised Walk: {11} But as for me, I shall walk in my integrity;
  - C2 His Request for Gracious Redemption: Redeem me, and be gracious to me.
- B3 His Confidence in Yahweh's Acceptance 26:12
  - C1 His Restatement of His Own Integrity: {12} My foot stands on a level place;
  - C2 His Intention to Worship Yahweh in the Sanctuary: In the congregations I shall bless the LORD.
