- C1 For Salvation 54:1
  - D1 Salvation: {1} Save me, O God, by Your name,
  - D2 Vindication: And vindicate me by Your power.
- C2 For Hearing 54:2
  - D1  $\{2\}$  Hear my prayer, O God;
  - D2 Give ear to the words of my mouth.
