A1 THE PSALMIST'S ANGUISHED CRY OF HUMAN ABANDONMENT 142:1-4

B1 His Audible Cry 142:1

- C1 Vocal Cry: *{1}* I cry aloud with my voice to the LORD;
- C2 Vocal Request: I make supplication with my voice to the LORD.

B2 His Troubled Complaint 142:2

- C1 Poured Out Complaint: {2} I pour out my complaint before Him;
- C2 Declared Trouble: I declare my trouble before Him.

B3 His Acknowledgment of Yahweh's Awareness of His Inner Agony 142:3

- C1 Yahweh's Awareness
 - D1 Overwhelmed spirit: {3} When my spirit was overwhelmed within me,
 - D2 Divine awareness: You knew my path.
- C2 Devious Trap
 - D1 Devious location: In the way where I walk
 - D2 Disguised trap: They have hidden a trap for me.

B4 His Feeling of Human Abandonment 142:4

- C1 No Regard
 - D1 $\{4\}$ Look to the right and see;
 - D2 For there is no one who regards me;
- C2 No Escape: There is no escape for me;
- C3 No Concern: No one cares for my soul.

A2 THE PSALMIST'S RELIANCE ON YAHWEH FOR DELIVERANCE 142:5-7

B1 His Reliance upon Yahweh as His Refuge 142:5

- C1 His Audible Cry: {5} I cried out to You, O LORD;
- C2 His Trust in Yahweh
 - D1 I said, "You are my refuge,
 - D2 My portion in the land of the living.

B2 His Request for Deliverance from His Persecutors 142:6

- C1 His Plea for a Hearing
 - D1 His plea: $\{6\}$ "Give heed to my cry,
 - D2 His reason: For I am brought very low;
- C2 His Plea for Deliverance
 - D1 His plea: Deliver me from my persecutors,
 - D2 His reason: For they are too strong for me.

B3 His Request for Escape and His Faith in Yahweh's Salvation 142:7

- C1 His Request for Escape
 - D1 From prison: {7} "Bring my soul out of prison,
 - D2 For thanks: So that I may give thanks to Your name;
- C2 His Assurance of Deliverance
 - D1 Surrounded by the righteous: The righteous will surround me,
 - D2 Blessed by Yahweh: For You will deal bountifully with me."
