- B1 David's Resolve to Bless the Name of His Elohim Always 145:1-2
  - C1 The Submission of David's Praise 145:1
    - D1 Extolling Elohim as his King: {1} I will extol You, my God, O King,
    - D2 Eternally blessing His name: And I will bless Your name forever and ever.
  - C2 The Perpetuity of David's Praise 145:2
    - D1 Blessing Elohim daily: {2} Every day I will bless You,
    - D2 Eternally praising His name: And I will praise Your name forever and ever.

- C1 The Justification for His Prediction: The Greatness of Yahweh 145:3
  - D1 The praiseworthiness of Yahweh's greatness: {3} Great is the LORD, and highly to be praised,

- C2 The Essence of His Prediction: The Preservation of the Praise of Yahweh's Works 145:4-7
  - D1 Corporate education 145:4
    - El Inter-generational praise of His works: {4} One generation shall praise Your works to another,
    - E2 Declaration of His mighty acts: And shall declare Your mighty acts.

"Here begins the grand doxology of the entire collection, for praise plays a greater part of Psalms 145-150 than in most of the others. The word 'praise' occurs 46 times in these six psalms" (Allen P. Ross, Psalms, *The Bible Knowledge Commentary* [*TBKC*]).

- D2 Personal meditation 145:5
  - E1 On Yahweh's splendid majesty: {5} On the glorious splendor of Your majesty
  - E2 On Yahweh's wonderful works: And on Your wonderful works, I will meditate.
- D3 Deliberate rehearsal of Yahweh's conduct 145:6
  - E1 Corporate declaration of Yahweh's powerful actions: *{6}* Men shall speak of the power of Your awesome acts,
  - E2 Personal reminder of Yahweh's greatness: And I will tell of Your greatness.
- D4 Exuberant utterance of Yahweh's character 145:7
  - E1 Eagerly extolling His vast virtue: {7} They shall eagerly utter the memory of Your abundant goodness
  - E2 Joyfully shouting His rectitude: And will shout joyfully of Your righteousness.

    - D1 His gracious mercy: {8} The LORD is gracious and merciful;
    - D2 His forbearing loyal love: Slow to anger and great in lovingkindness.
  - C2 Yahweh's Merciful Works 145:9-10
    - D1 The statement of His merciful works 145:9
      - E1 His universal goodness: {9} The LORD is good to all,
      - E2 His totally merciful works: And His mercies are over all His works.
    - D2 The consequences of His merciful works 145:10
      - E1 Universal thanks: {10} All Your works shall give thanks to You, O LORD,
      - E2 Laudatory blessings from the godly: And Your godly ones shall bless You.

  - D1 Revealing His mighty acts: {12} To make known to the sons of men Your mighty acts
  - D2 Explaining the glorious majesty of His rule: And the glory of the majesty of Your kingdom.
- C3 Acknowledging the Eternal Ubiquity of His Kingdom 145:13
  - D1 Its eternal existence: {13} Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom,
  - D2 Its ubiquitous rule: And Your dominion *endures* throughout all generations.

- C1 His Care for the Lowly 145:14
  - D1 Sustaining the fallen: {14} The LORD sustains all who fall
  - D2 Raising the stooped: And raises up all who are bowed down.
- C2 His Timely, Universal Provision of Food 145:15
  - D1 The dependence of all: {15} The eyes of all look to You,
  - D2 His timely nourishment: And You give them their food in due time.<sup>2</sup>
- C3 His Generous, Universal Satisfaction of All Creatures 145:16
  - D1 His generosity: {16} You open Your hand
  - D2 His universal gratification: And satisfy the desire of every living thing.

C1 The Righteousness and Kindness of All Yahweh's Ways 145:17

- D1 His righteousness: {17} The LORD is righteous in all His ways
- D2 His kindness: And kind in all His deeds.
- C2 Yahweh's Support of All Who Call on Him and His Destruction of the Wicked 145:18-20
  - D1 His nearness to those who call on Him sincerely 145:18
    - E1 The nearness of Yahweh: {18} The LORD is near to all who call upon Him,
    - E2 The sincerity of the caller: To all who call upon Him in truth.
  - D2 His salvation of those who fear Him 145:19
    - E1 Fulfilling their desire: {19} He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him;
    - E2 Hearing and saving them: He will also hear their cry and will save them.
  - D3 His preservation of those who love him and destruction of the wicked 145:20
    - E1 Yahweh's preservation of all who love Him: {20} The LORD keeps all who love Him,
    - E2 Yahweh's destruction of the wicked: But all the wicked He will destroy.

- **B1** David's Resolve to Praise Yahweh: {21} My mouth will speak the praise of the LORD,
- **B2** David's Prediction of Universal, Eternal Praise of Yahweh: And all flesh will bless His holy name forever and ever.<sup>3</sup>
