¹ Question 17 - connection: My guess is that the 144,000 Israelis told multitudes of people the good news about Jesus. A great many people trusted in Jesus, but were put to death because of their faith and their unwillingness to submit to the regime of the Antichrist, or False Messiah.

D. Some important lessons:

- 1. Right now almost no Jewish people believe in Jesus as their Messiah. Some day that will change in a most remarkable way. 7:1-8
- 2. Satan is the ultimate counterfeiter. He will try to replace God's sealing of people with his own sealing. 7:4-8 cf. 13:16-18
- 3. Huge numbers of people will come to place their faith in Jesus during the Great Tribulation. Most of them will be martyred for their faith. 7:9-17
- 4. Jesus is the Great Shepherd. He is the only one who can satisfy all the physical as well as spiritual needs that every human has. 7:16-17.
- 5. Only God, finally, can wipe away human tears. 7:17
